

# Reading the Schedule

The top bars on the schedule have information for each school group that will be on campus for that week. Once you have located your school name, you can look across to find your homeroom space listed above the name of your lead teacher, you dorm room assignments, your meal times and locations, your arrival and departure times with your first and last meal, your assigned times for the school store, and the name of your liaison. The color of the bar with your school's information also corresponds to the color of the bar that you should look at to find your school's classes for each day.

Each day is separated by a gray bar with the date.

Evening classes like Ropes Course and Canoeing go from 6:30-9:15 pm and will have a box around them.

The number on the side refers to your school (see top bar for number) and the letter corresponds to individual learning groups.

This section shows which class each learning group has for that class period. Each color bar is a different school group.

This section indicated the room the class starts in. ED = Education Building SC = Science Center

This section tells you which Wolf Ridge Naturalist is teaching the class.

Evening programs are large group presentations that are led by a Wolf Ridge Naturalist. These go from 6:30-7:15 pm.

Evening activities will be set up for your group from 6:30-8 pm, and are led by your adults.

Night classes show up here. Astronomy is taught by a Wolf Ridge Naturalist and Campfire is led by your adults.
