Arrival & Departure

A five-day (four nights) trip typically starts on Monday with an 11 am arrival followed by lunch. Departure is Friday no later than 1pm, after breakfast or hot lunch/ bag lunch. You will indicate your first and last meal choices on the Group Information and Schedule Requests. Personal belongings should be moved out of dorm rooms and placed to the side in your homeroom by 9 am.

A three-day (two nights) trip is Mon-Wed, Wed-Fri, or Fri-Sun. Check in for Monday or Wednesday is typically an 11 am arrival followed by lunch. Departure is no later than 1pm, after breakfast or hot lunch/ bag lunch on Wednesday or Friday. Weekend groups check in at 4pm and dinner is their first meal. Departure is Sunday after breakfast or hot lunch/ bag lunch. Personal belongings should be moved out of dorm rooms and placed to the side in your homeroom by 9 am.

Liaisons

You will be assigned a liaison who will meet you at your dorm when you arrive and help you move in. They will do a large group orientation for your students and staff, and then meet with you to go over more details for your stay. Your liaison will be your first point of contact for most things, and will help you with any questions you have, arrange necessary equipment, and coordinate evening activities. Your liaison will be around for most meals to check-in with you, and can be contacted by dialing 172 on any of the landlines at Wolf Ridge.

Daytime Class Offerings

Wolf Ridge instructors teach all daytime classes at Wolf Ridge, unless a visiting teacher requests to teach. Daytime classes are scheduled from 8:30-11:30am and 1:30-4:30pm. Classes meet in the Education Building, the Science Center, or the lobby of the dorm. Students are expected to come to class prepared for the weather. Group meetings before classes are a good time to review how to be prepared for the day. Class size is around 20 including students and adults.

All day Classes

These take place from 8:30-4:30 at our Forest Ecology Building site. Different classes (as noted below) can be combined to create an all day field site experience. On-site lunch is provided. During the cold season we provide an on-site warm meal.

Evening Programs

An evening naturalist presentation is provided from 6:30-7:15 pm. Wolf Ridge staff will utilize slides, theatrics, and audience participation to highlight a specific piece of natural or cultural history. Evening programs are assigned to groups and are scheduled the week prior to your visit. They may include: The Night Sky, Fur Trade, History of the North Shore, Wolves, Raptors, Bats, and Logging Camp Life.

Evening Classes

Evening classes go from 6:30-9:15pm. These are either taught by Wolf Ridge Naturalists, or by your adults. Three adults from your group must be supervisors during both the Indoor Rock Climbing and Adventure Ropes. Two adults must be prepared to go up in towers for the Adventure Ropes Course. Due to site limitations, we can only guarantee five-day groups both Rocks and Ropes. Three-day groups may get one or the other.

Evening Activities

Evening activities are from 6:30-8:00pm. Your adults facilitate and teach the evening activities. Lesson plans and equipment are provided by Wolf Ridge, and instructional videos on how to facilitate the activities can be found on our [YouTube channel](#). Your liaison will set up the evening activities for you.

Additional Evening Opportunities

There are additional optional evening activities that occur from 8:00-9:00 pm. These include a campfire, which is led by your adults, or astronomy, which is led by a Wolf Ridge Naturalist. Please indicate on your Class Scheduling form if you would like either of these added to your schedule.

Science Center Store

20 students at a time will be allowed in the store and an adult from your group must be present to monitor students. You may be scheduled at the same time as another group. Please indicate your interest in the store on the Group Information and Schedule Form. You can shop for some things ahead of time through the online store.

Homeroms

You will be assigned a homeroom in your dorm for meeting and gathering during your stay and for storing luggage before you depart. Please only use the homeroom that is assigned to your group.
