Eligibility: Scholarship funds are available for student tuition and students need to be Minnesota residents.

Submission of Application: Applications are considered on an ongoing basis. To be considered please **submit your application three weeks prior to your trip.** Return applications electronically to: scheduling@wolf-ridge.org

Notification: If funded, you will receive email notification regarding the amount and type of support awarded. You will then be asked to formally accept via reply email. Support routed through Wolf Ridge will appear as a credit on your invoice following your Wolf Ridge stay.

Reporting: Scholarship recipients are required to provide a report that includes 3-4 photos with accompanying stories describing the value of the Wolf Ridge experience to their families. This can be written as a word/Google document or sent through an email to scheduling@wolf-ridge.org. **The report** is due no later than one month after your date of departure.
